) PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

20 The application for the preliminary injunction herein
21 made came regularly on for hearing on SEPTEMBER 12, 1977 pur-
22 suant to an Order to Show Cause why a preliminary injunction
23 should not issue in this matter. The firm of Cohen, England,
24 Whitfield & Osborne, by James L. Spencer, appeared as counsel for
25 plaintiffs. NO ONE appeared as counsel for
26 defendant Ann Baker, aka Florence Ann Baker, individually and
27 doing business as Raggedy Ann Cattery, NO APPEARANCE BY DEFENDANT

28 The matter having been argued, the Court having considered
29 all of the evidence presented and good cause appearing therefore:

30 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, during the pendency of this
31 action and until a final judgment is entered, defendant Ann Baker,
32 also known as Florence Ann Baker, individually and doing business
33 as Raggedy Ann Cattery, her agents, employees, representatives,
34 and all persons and entities acting in concert with said defendant
35 shall be and are hereby restrained and enjoined from either di-
36 rectly or indirectly: (1) publishing, circulating and/or

1 disseminating advertisements or literature implying, inferring or
2 asserting that Ragdoll cats not sold, or not approved or crested,
3 by defendant Ann Baker are not authentic specimens of the Ragdoll
4 breed of cat; (2) publishing, circulating and/or distributing
5 advertising and literature implying, inferring or asserting that
6 Ragdoll cats bred and sold by the plaintiffs are not authentic
7 specimens of the Ragdoll breed of cats; (3) publishing, circula-
8 ting and/or disseminating to public officials allegations that
9 the plaintiffs are defrauding the public; (4) publishing and cir-
10 culating such material to, or asserting to any local, regional,
11 national or international cat association that cats bred and sold
12 by plaintiffs are not authentic specimens of the Ragdoll breed of
13 cats; (5) interfering with plaintiffs' relations with any local,
14 regional, or national cat association; (6) publishing, circulating
15 and/or distributing advertisements and literature implying, in-
16 ferring or asserting that said defendant has or can offer
17 franchises unless and until said defendant obtains a valid permit
18 to offer and/or sell franchises from the California Department of
19 Corporations; (7) publishing, circulating and/or distributing ad-
20 vertising literature implying, inferring or asserting that adver-
21 tising for the sale of breeding pairs of Ragdoll cats must be
22 approved by the Department of Corporations through the defendant.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this preliminary injunction
24 shall become effective upon plaintiffs' filing of an undertaking
25 in the sum of 1000.00.


