

**OFFICIAL STATEMENT FROM THE EXECUTIVE BOARD
OF THE RAGDOLLS OF AMERICA GROUP:**

We are pleased to announce that on February 7, 1998 in Houston, Texas, the CFA Board of Directors approved the advancement of the BICOLOR RAGDOLL from Miscellaneous to Provisional status effective May 1, 1998. They also accepted for the Bicolor, REDS, LYNX, DILUTES AND ALL COMBINATIONS OF THESE COLORS. However, they did not accept any outcrossing at this time. They continue to require a three generation pedigree.

For showing CFA, Provisional Breeds compete separately as kittens, adult whole cats, or altered cats within their breed for First, Second, Third (separated by sex), Best of Color Class and 2nd Best of Color Class. One color class per breed per CFA Show Rules Article 1, 1.18 Non-Championship Classes (C).
